Discussion Starter Questions

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1. We live in a time when many people reason that they need to have sexual experience before marriage as a trial for marriage – that it will help the marriage relationship. What is the truth?
2. Avoiding infidelity is an important part of protecting marriage, but that doesn't ensure that a marriage is honoring God. What does God want a Christian marriage to look like?
3. God used His prophet Hosea as a living illustration of God's love for Israel. God required great sacrifice and heartache from Hosea. And Hosea obeyed. How does that affect or inspire you?
4. How does living by God's values protect a marriage?
5. How does nurturing the primary family relationship protect a marriage?
6. How does learning to fight well protect a marriage?
7. How does rejecting secrecy protect a marriage?
8. How does practicing selfless love protect a marriage?
9. Many people expect marriage to be a magical experience where romance, routines and relationship simply falls neatly into place. But God meant for marriage to be a refining ground. If you are married, in what ways has marriage refined you? If you are not married, what areas in your life do you think God might want to refine you?
