

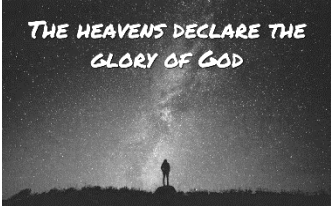
Sunday AM Sermon – October 24, 2021

Glorify God

Psalm 29:1-9



Imagine being Moses. He went up on Mount Sinai to be with God for 40 days and nights. When he came back down, people had to shield their eyes to look at him. The glory of God remained so bright on Moses that it practically blinded them. What's that all about?
