

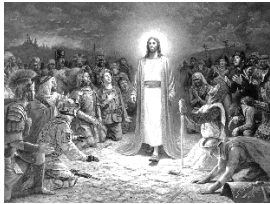
Sunday AM Sermon – March 13, 2022

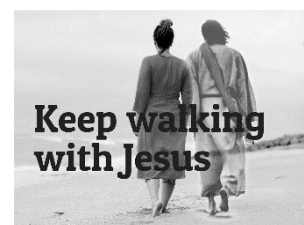
