Philippians 3:17-21

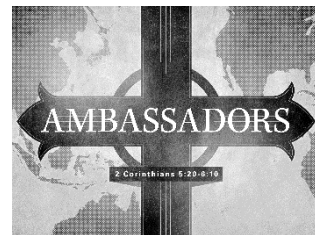
