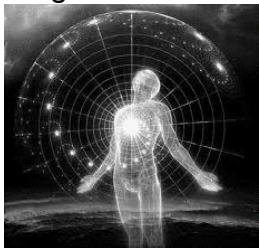


Sunday AM Sermon – May 29, 2022

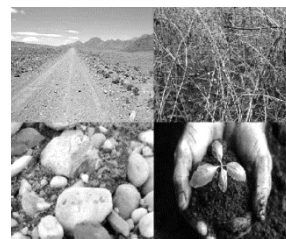
