

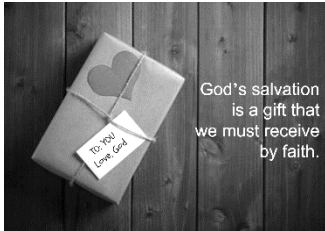
Sunday AM Sermon – December 25, 2022
